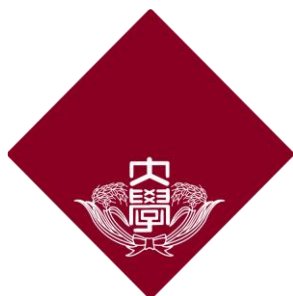


About Our Scholarship Program

In 1995, JCCI Singapore Foundation started to provide scholarship **with NO-BOND** attached, to commemorate Singapore's 30th Year of National Independence and the 5th Anniversary of JCCI Singapore Foundation. Since then, collaboration with various universities in Japan has been established with the aim to provide young Singaporeans an opportunity to study in Japan. Also, the Foundation wishes to promote further exchanges and cooperation between Singapore and Japan. JCCI scholars are thus expected to play the role of a diplomat with the task of strengthening bilateral relations between the two nations during and after the scholarship programs.

Currently, the Foundation is offering two scholarships to local undergraduates for one-year (September 2020 to July 2021) study programs in Japan, in cooperation with Waseda University and International Christian University (ICU). Application open takes place between June and September every year.
